Ecclesia Reformata, Semper Reformanda

Happy Birthday to us! Sort of. Reformation, the unofficial birthday of the Lutheran Church, is celebrated the last Sunday of October, with the official date being October 31. This year we will celebrate Reformation and Confirmation Sunday at St. John's on Sunday, October 29. Please wear red clothing to worship as red is the color of celebration in the church.

A key figure in this "reforming" of the Christian church was a 16th century monk named Martin Luther. Among his many life-changing ideas, one of my favorites is what he called *the priest-hood of all believers*. Before Luther, the Christian church taught that one had to use a priest as a mediator between them and God. The priest would pray for the person and determine what God might want them to do in response to their confession or request.

Luther was inspired when he read this verse from 1 Peter, verses 4-5:

The Lord Jesus is the living stone. The people of the world decided that they did not want this stone. But he is the one God chose as one of great value. So come to him. You also are like living stones, and God is using you to build a spiritual house. You are to serve God in this house as holy priests, offering him spiritual sacrifices that he will accept because of Jesus Christ.

For Luther, this was a major game-changer. This meant that all humans have access to God through Christ, the true high priest, and do not need a priestly mediator. This introduced a democratic element in the functioning of the church that meant all Christians were equal. The priests have their unique work, but it was equal to the work of every other Christian. The Sunday School teacher, the janitor, the home-bound member making phone calls for the congregation – everyone is a "priest" or "minister" that can connect with God and serve a vital function in their church family.

Each one of us is called to serve the Gospel. We are part of a congregation or parish to serve and be served. When someone joined the new, first-century Christian church, they were assigned to serve in a particular ministry. And the church was made aware of everyone's need as well. Could we strive for that today? Could we ask each other to serve and be served so the work of the Gospel could be evident in every member, of every age, in every stage of life?

This is possible because of the great motto of the Reformation, *Ecclesia Reformata, Semper Reformanda:* the church reformed and always reforming. The work of the church calls us to spread the Gospel as we manage the twists and turns of our world, the difficulties, the divisions and disappointments. The message of the Gospel is constant, but the method is always reforming in order to keep communicating the transforming Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Let us pray. Reforming God, by your Spirit, may each of us find our place in the priesthood of all believers that is Trinity Valley Lutheran Parish. As our ministries serve us, may we serve each other and our community as well, so we may celebrate the unique gifts of every person as we remain united in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Guide us to develop disciples and connect to Christ. Amen.


