# Pastor's Article for March 2024 • Interim Pastor Bob Friese

I believe I know every inch of the room, even though it is a massive space. I know the "secret" stairway, the spot for the best acoustics, and each nook and cranny of the balcony. I still marvel at the massive walls of stained glass that enclose the room on three sides. And I remember the special events that happened in that space, including my confirmation and the weddings of my two sisters.

The sanctuary of my home church has a hold on my heart, even though I haven't been there for over ten years. I can still smell the sweet fragrance of the lilies filling the space on Easter morning and I still feel the excitement of seeing the glorious and sparkling Christmas decorations.

One of the most memorable events was the 11 p.m. Good Friday service. At the end of the service, the sanctuary was dark, and a single lit candle was on the altar. When the candle was extinguished, there was an ominous rumble followed by a thunderous BANG from the kettle drum up in the balcony. This signified the moment of Jesus' death, the moment that all seemed lost, and that we were forever separated from God. We'd leave in nearly total darkness and our conversations were hushed and low.

As I reached my early teens, Good Friday made me feel like I was part of the audience that first heard the Beatitudes from Jesus. I felt we were all mournful and abandoned on Good Friday, but holding onto the encouraging words of our Savior, "Blessed are you...". Attending that Good Friday service made Easter morning all the more special, more special because we knew that whatever darkness and abandonment we felt, Jesus had felt it too. And on Easter, Christ's resurrection proclaims that the Light of God that has overcome the darkness will never be put out, never overwhelmed by the gloom of all that is evil and unholy. I thank God for all these glorious experiences.

It was my great pleasure to spend Lent, Holy Week, and Easter with our parish last year, since my interim work began March 1, 2023. The sanctuaries in which we worship are still a bit foreign to me, and I still check my steps when moving around the chancels and pulpits of our three churches. These spaces are much smaller and less grand than my home church. But Lent, Holy Week, and Easter were just as transformative and inspirational for me. WHERE we spent our time really meant little to me, yet WHAT we did in that space, and the faithful and loving people WITH WHOM we shared that time made everything just as inspiring and life-giving as my childhood experiences in that huge church with 4000 members and four services every Sunday.

Whenever I am with faithful Christians who are joining in Christ-centered worship, I am home. So when I get to be with you all, whether at Gilman, St. John's, or Spring Lake, I am reminded that Christ's resurrection proclaims that the Light of God that has overcome the darkness will never be put out, never overwhelmed by the gloom of all that is evil and unholy. I thank God for all these glorious experiences.

Each one of our sanctuaries is unique and beautiful. But what makes each one holy and Christ-like is who is in that place on any given day, regardless of which church they believe is their "home church." Thriving as a parish is challenging, but we are doing it well. And, our parish is a foretaste of what Jesus promises us, that is, membership in a community not defined by church, denomination, or any human limitation, but defined by lives that are shaped by, inspired by, and restored by Jesus Christ, the true Son of God who takes away the sins of the world and loves us unconditionally with a love beyond human understanding.
