Lent is a season for reflection and repentance. We take time to examen ourselves and our lives and recommit ourselves to following the way of Jesus Christ, which will lead us straight to the cross. In Lent many of us choose to deny ourselves something, like chocolate, coffee, swearing, alcohol, etc., as a way to live into Jesus' teaching to "deny yourselves and take up your cross and follow me" (Matt. 16:24) Let's not confuse the matter. Giving up chocolate is not the same as dying on the cross. However, it does give us a taste of denying ourselves. The intention then is whenever we would crave what we have chosen to abstain from we would spend that time in prayer, praise, thanksgiving. This is a very meaningful Lenten discipline for many.

Some choose not to 'give something up' but instead choose to take something up. This is in living into Jesus' words and commandment "Love one another as I have loved you" (John 13:34-35) In serving the poor, helping the elderly, visiting the sick, or choosing to do chores that are not designated as 'yours', or spending time with by yourself or with others reading scripture and praying you demonstrate this command.

In one church I served we called this discipline "taking up the towel" echoing in scripture when Jesus washed the disciples' feet. It is caring for the other, and in essence also a form of 'denying yourself' and following Jesus.

I do not advocate one discipline or practice over the other. Both have their purpose, place, and time. What I do advocate for is for you to consider deepening your Lenten experience by choosing one of these practices this Lent. If you haven't started, begin now. If you start and stall, begin again. In this way, as we learn and grow together in our Lenten sermon series "Sir, We Want to See Jesus" we *will see Jesus*.



BIBLE CAMP

At Trinity Valley Parish we ask that confirmation students attend "Jr. High/ Confirmation Camp" at Luther Point Bible Camp at least once during the summer before their 7th, 8th, or 9th grade. This year we are scheduled to attend during the week of **July 18-23**rd.

This experience is designed to help campers gain independence, meet new friends and take ownership of their faith through worship, Bible studies and other fun activities. These will include an Outpost adventure, service projects, low-ropes course and more!

Gilman/Spring Lake congregations will pay the great majority of the \$405 cost for each first-time student through grants and fundraisers. But we request that \$135 deposit be paid by the student's family if at all possible.

Due to the uncertainty that goes along with COVID-19, Luther Point takes everything "one-day-at-a-time". They are planning on holding the full summer program, however are prepared to make changes as necessary to limit group sizes. They are also waiving cancellation fees up until May 1, 2021 if you need to cancel your reservation for any reason.

It is very important that <u>you register your student online</u>, to avoid a \$25 added fee. For the church to get the early-bird discount of \$15 per student, <u>you will need to go online to complete the registration and pay the deposit by May 1st.</u> Information regarding camp is available at <u>www.lutherpoint.org</u>. If you are unable to pay this deposit, please contact Pastor so that we can find some way to help. Watch for a future mailing.

Joint Council Meeting: Gilman, St. John's, & Spring Lake (2/19/21 ZOOM)

Meeting was called to order at 6:33 by Parish Council President, Karen Gunderson. Pastor Amelia opened the meeting with Devotions and Prayer speaking about trusting in God during change, and choosing not to be fear filled.

Karen expressed thanks for the prompt and encouraging email responses regarding return to in-church worship. She noted that since the worship schedule will change quarterly, Easter Sunday will be the first Sunday in the next quarter, so the rotation schedule will change **on Easter Sunday** and it will be important to advertise that time change frequently, and well in advance.

Pastor informed us that she will require assistance to have things ready to go at each of the last 2 churches in the rotation since she will be traveling between 3 churches for Sunday services and will be unable to do it herself. She will compose a list of things that she needs to be in place prior to the services. She announced that Lenten Imposition of Ashes will be held on Feb. 17th via drive through at St. John's at 11-12 and 6-7, and that there were also individual kits available for pick up at the church office if members would prefer to do this at home. All Lenten Services will be held online (TVLP YouTube page) and then the Sunday services will resume according to their rotation schedule on Feb. 14th.

Call committee members Diane Hurtgen, Nancy Cleveland, and Trudy Rew reported that they had a mock interview practice (recommended by the Synod prior to actual candidate interviews) and Karen confirmed that a donation was sent to that pastor's preferred charity as a thank you. The committee has 2 interviews scheduled the 11th and 15th of February. They requested prayers of support during the interview process.

Lisa Nelson has been working on a Trinity Valley Lutheran Parish Website that will contain information pertinent to the parish, but that will also link to each of the 3 churches from the parish site. She is looking for interested people to provide feedback about the content of this website and will send a Zoom link to those expressing interest. The meeting will be 2/16/21.

We will trial joint council meetings with a brief parish council meeting altogether, and then breaking out into individual church council meetings so that the pastor is able to "attend" all 3 church meetings on the same night. In the future, individual meetings could either be before the joint meeting, or afterward. The meetings are on the second Tuesday of the month. Tentative start times for the joint meeting will be 6:30 or 6:45. Watch for further details.

Dale Place presented some finance questions regarding Portico, payroll, office administrator payroll, frequency of pastor's reimbursement.

Jeremy Johnson announced that there will be a "Fun Day" at Lake George behind the Dam in Spring Valley from 1-3:30 on Sunday, February 28th. There will be kick ball, skating, bonfire. Initial invitation was to all students from the 3 churches along with their families, but after some discussion it was opened to all interested members.

Joint council adjourned at 7:10 p.m. into breakout meetings of the individual councils.
